Dear Parent or Guardian:

This letter is being sent in preparation for the 2022-2023 school year. New York State law requires that each child in a school district have a school health examination, also known as a health appraisal or a health physical, including body mass index, and also *recommends* a complete dental examination, prior to entering school. A school health examination is required for grades PreK, Kindergarten, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11 students. These examinations/appraisals may be completed up to one year to the month before your child begins these grades, as an exam is valid for a full year through the last day of the month in which the exam was conducted. Additionally, new entrants to the district, students wishing to play interscholastic sports, and students desiring work permits must have an annual school health examination. Your health care provider is most familiar with the medical history of your child and is able to start treatment when necessary. Therefore, the district recommends that all examinations be made by your health care provider. Completed school health examination forms, health appraisal or physical forms may be directly mailed or faxed to the school nurse from the provider's office.

Also accompanying this letter is information regarding the New York State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance. All children in a prekindergarten through grade 12 setting should be age-appropriately immunized and families should consult with their health care provider to ensure compliance with these requirements. If you are experiencing difficulty with obtaining required immunizations from your primary care physician, please contact my office at 349-5150. **Please be aware that proof of required immunizations are due on the first day of school of the 2022-2023 school year or students are at risk of school exclusion.**
